Principal's Message

Progress Reports:

On November 10th your child will be coming home with a Progress Report Card. The purpose of this report card is to share information with you about your child's progress early in the school year. This report card will focus on your child's development of their learning skills and work habits, as well as your child's general progress in working towards their achievement of the curriculum expectations at their grade level. It is very important that you, the parent, take this opportunity to understand your child's progress at this early point in the school year.

This report card does not include marks or letter grades, but rather progress will be reported by indicating if your child is "progressing with difficulty", "progressing well", or "progressing very well". There will not be a comment for every subject area on this report card. There will be a comment for math and language and for any subject where your child is doing very well or is progressing with difficulty.

All parents will have the opportunity for a face to face interview with your child's teacher either on the evening of November 17th or at another prearranged date. More information regarding parent interviews will be sent home through a separate notice.
